General Description

The Finance Trainer Cyber*School is a training course specially designed to help you memorise the course material and develop a thorough understanding of the subject matter. Thanks to the clear structure of the course you can easily find the topics that are of interest to you. The decision, when to learn and how long your training sessions should last, is entirely yours.

Training in the Cyber*School should be fun and rewarding. On the statistics page you can check your results to date and compare your performance (level 3 chapter tests, world tests as well as complete and final test) to that of your fellow Cyber*Students.

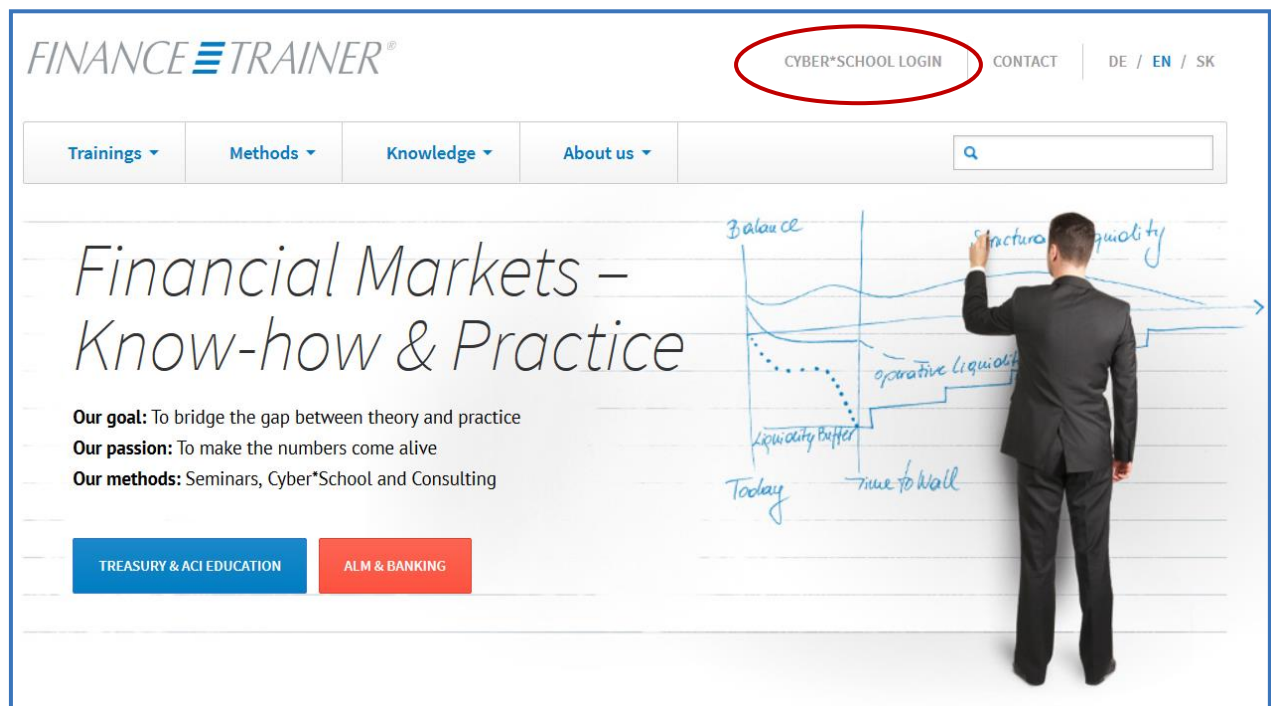
You conclude the training course with the final test which covers the entire course contents. You receive a Cyber*School Report certifying the successful completion of the course which will be sent as pdf file by mail.

World 1 | Money Market

The clear structure into worlds and chapters helps you obtain a quick overview of the available material and decide on your personal learning style and speed.

A world represents the covered learning topic and consists of several chapters. A chapter is the smallest learning unit.

Script and Levels

Upon entering the Cyber*School you see the entire course contents divided into worlds with their corresponding chapters. Each chapter contains a script (PDF file) as well as tests on three levels. The script opens in a new window or tab (depending on your browser settings), you may print it out if you wish. The script contains the entire knowledge necessary for answering the questions in the chapter tests. Depending on your preferences, you may first study the script or, alternatively, start with the tests right away. Tests get increasingly harder as you advance from level one to three.

Levels

Level 1

Helps you memorise the basic knowledge contained in the script. Following the chronology of the script, it asks questions regarding the relevant chapter. Immediately after depositing your answer by clicking on „Submit“ the correct answer and an explanation are shown in the right-hand column.

Upon opening a level 1 test the overview appears. At a glance you see how many questions are contained in the test. You may directly access any question by clicking on the corresponding button. Your personal status is saved during the test session. The next time you start with the status of your previous session: this way you can directly tackle your „problem“ questions. Please make sure to end the test by closing the browser window or tab. (By clicking on „End test“ you reset your status and would thus get a completely new test next time round.)

Level 2

Checks whether you can put the learned knowledge into a wider context and have properly memorised the subject matter. The questions vary in form but not in substance and appear randomly. Immediately after depositing your answer by clicking on „Submit“ the correct answer and an explanation are shown in the right-hand column.

Upon opening a level 2 test the overview appears. At the beginning of each session, your question status is set back, that is, you start with a blank page.

Level 3

This chapter test prepares you for the world test and complete test. It works similar to the level 2 test. However, there is a time limit and you receive no explanation.

The countdown starts upon launching the test. When time is up the test finishes automatically.

Upon opening a level 3 test the overview appears. Your best level 3 result is saved and displayed on the statistics page alongside the course average.

To find out which questions you answered incorrectly click on „See test results“ on the right-hand side below the statistic bars. You may now again practice the questions marked red. Your test result remains unchanged.

Question Types

Single Response Questions (select your answer via corresponding radio button)

Only one of the shown answers is correct and may be chosen. You may change your choice repeatedly until you are certain. By clicking „Submit“ you enter your current choice.

Multiple Response Questions (select your answers via corresponding check box)

Several of the listed answers are correct and may be selected by a single mouse click and deselected again by a further mouse click. The number of correct answers varies. The question is answered correctly when all possible choices are selected. You may change your choice repeatedly until you are certain. By clicking „Submit“ you enter your current choice.

Sorting Questions

The listed answers can be sorted by dragging with the left mouse button depressed. The answer is correct when all choices are in the proper order. You may change your choice repeatedly until you are certain. By clicking „Submit“ you enter your current choice.

Calculation Questions

You are asked to estimate or calculate the correct answer (NO grouping of large numbers with a comma or space, decimals are marked with a full stop „.“, e.g. 230000.34). By clicking „Submit“ you enter your current input. The question is answered correctly if the entered value is within the given range. The range depends on the level of difficulty as well as possible rounding tolerances.

Wrong answer

The value date of a spot transaction is normally 2 working days after the deal has been traded. If the second day after trading is not a working day, then the next working day is the value date. **Thus Monday, 21 December is the correct value date.**

Level 1

When answering questions you may use the following buttons:

- ▶ **Submit:** Enters your choice/input for marking
- ▶ **Mark down question marked:** Helps you to come back to a particular question. These questions are marked with an asterisk „*“ on the overview page
- ▶ **back and forward:** Helps you to navigate the test, current choices/inputs are not marked

The status of each question is listed in the overview which can be accessed via the button „Overview“.

Points

Depending on the level of difficulty the points awarded may vary.

For non-answered questions no points are awarded, for incorrectly answered questions 0.25 points are deducted.

Tests

The following tests must be taken:

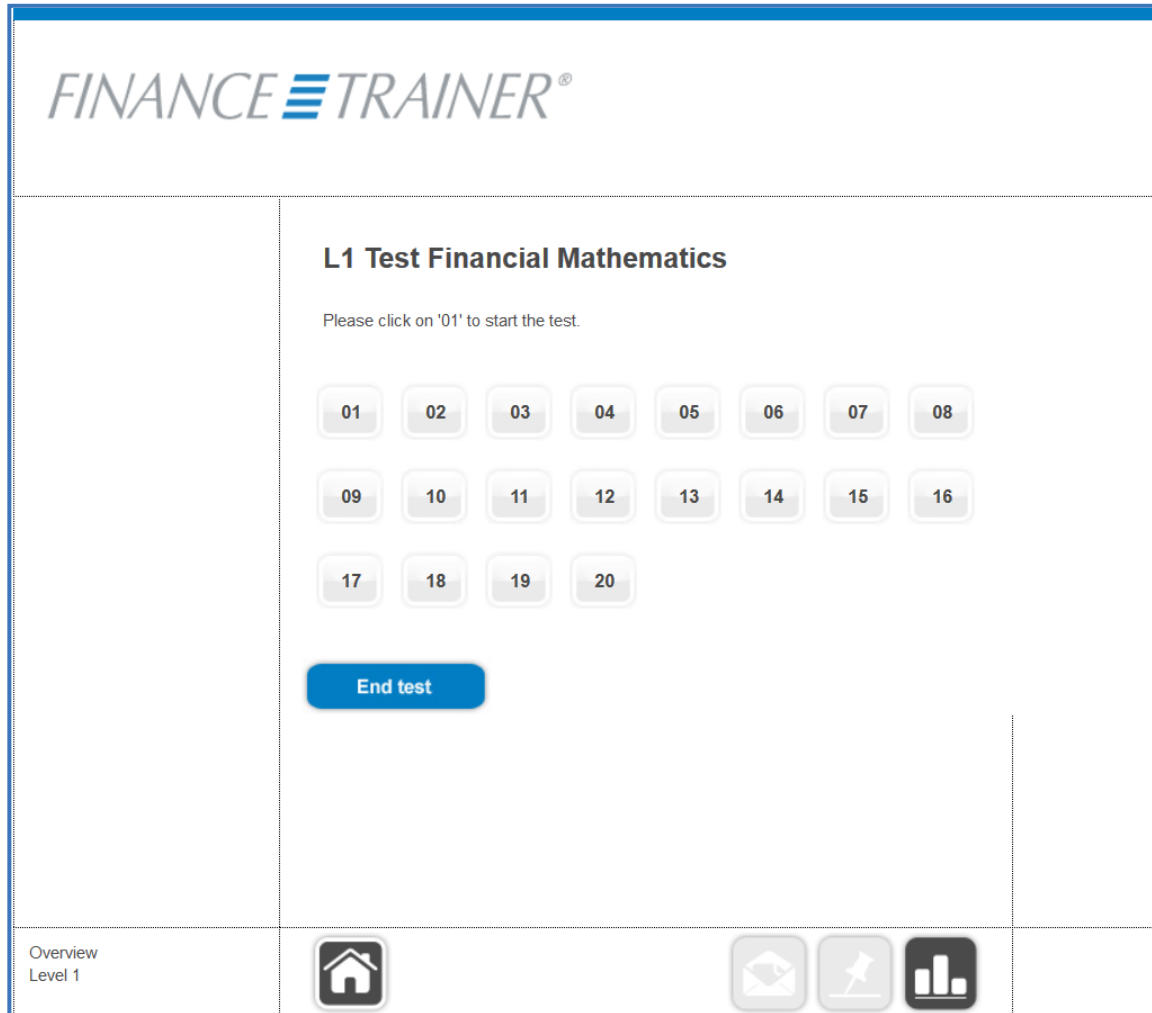
- ▶ Level 3 tests in each chapter
- ▶ World tests to check whether you have fully mastered the contents of all chapters in this world
- ▶ Complete test to check whether you have fully mastered the contents of all worlds in the Cyber*School
- ▶ Final test covering the entire Cyber*School. This test may be sit only once. Upon successful completion ($\geq 60\%$), you receive the Cyber*School Report as pdf file by mail.

In level 3 chapter tests, world test as well as in complete and final tests questions are displayed randomly. There is a time limit. Do not use too much time on individual questions: if you are stuck, mark down that particular question and move on to the next one. You may come back to the difficult questions later. When time is up, the test finishes automatically.

Your results in all level 3 chapter test, world tests as well as complete and final test are displayed on the statistics page. Results are shown in percent. As a benchmark you can see the course average of each test. By clicking on „Print screen“ you may print out the statistics.

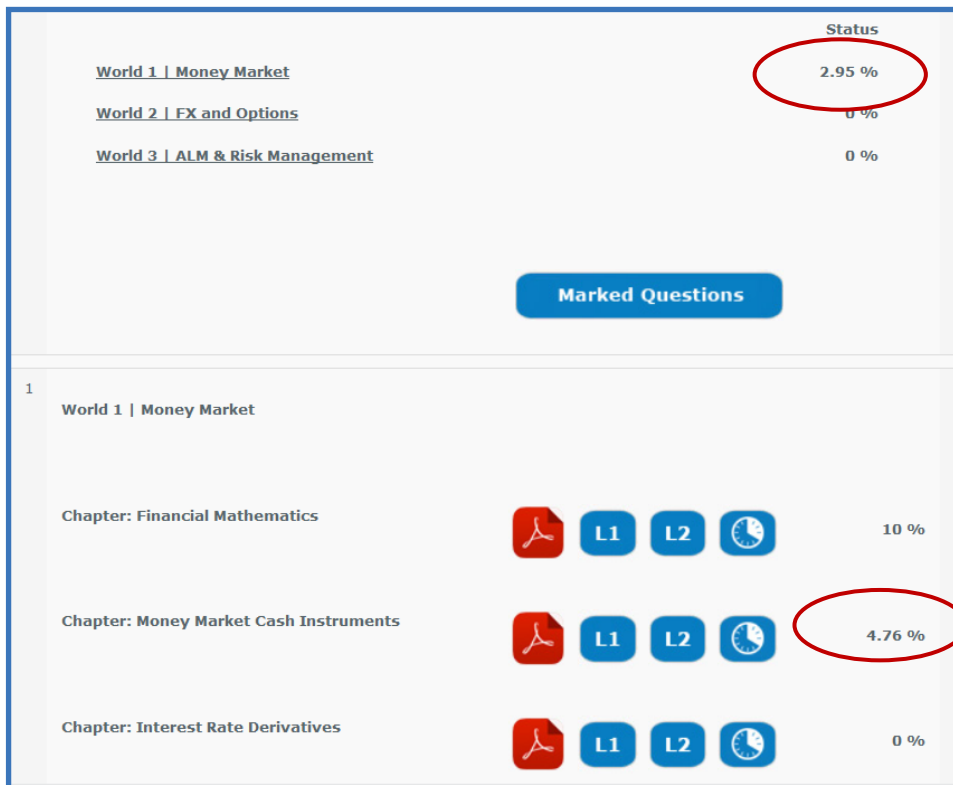
Test Overview

The Overview enables you to access questions directly in order to answer them or check them again for better memorising.



- ▶ Grey without marking: The question has not been answered yet
- ▶ Grey with an asterisk: The question has been marked, but not answered yet
- ▶ Green: The question has been answered correctly (chapter tests level 1 and 2).
- ▶ Red: The question has been answered incorrectly (chapter tests level 1 and 2) .
- ▶ Grey with a dark border: The question has been answered (chapter tests level 3, world tests as well as complete and final test)

Status



Result per chapter:

Best result from level 3 or number of correct answers / number of questions in the chapter

Result per world:

Best result from world test or average result from chapters

Navigation



Test overview

By clicking on „Test overview“ you obtain a list of all questions in the current test – their individual status is colour-coded and/or marked.



Ask the Cyber*Trainer

By clicking on „Ask the Cyber*Trainer“ you get a form for entering your question. By clicking on „Send message“ your message is sent. (The question ID is automatically included.) You will receive an answer by e-mail.




Mark down question

Should you wish to skip a question or return to it later, you may mark this questions by clicking on „Mark down question“. You will easily find this question again on the overview page – it is marked with an asterisk „*“.

All marked questions can also be found centrally in the upper part of your course in a "collection box".

Here you can call up individual questions and see immediately the correct answer. You can remove individual questions or delete them all at once with the button "remove all marked questions"
